Last week, markets moved up across the board, with the S&P 500 breaking its four-week streak of declines. We saw a modest pickup in stimulus hopes as Treasury Secretary Steve Mnuchin expressed plans to discuss a deal with Democrats. Then we learned that President Trump tested positive for COVID-19 and was hospitalized for the weekend. Stocks sold off Friday on the news.

Earlier last week, the President was encouraging congress to pass a COVID relief package very quickly. But after leaving the hospital Monday, he directed his representatives to stop negotiating and wait till after the election. He says after he wins, he'll pass a relief bill, but he objects to any assistance to states with Democrat leadership.
